

Pool Rules

- Animals are not allowed in pool area during public or private swim time.
- The following Items are not allowed at any City of La Porte Pool. Gum, Cigarettes, Tobacco Products or, Illegal Substance, Snorkels or, Tempered Glass Mask, Frisbees, Tennis Balls or, Hard Balls, Bicycles, Skateboards.
- The following situations are not allowed at any City of La Porte Pools. Diving in any area of the pools, Profanity, Hanging on Lane Ropes, Horse Play, The Throwing in of bathers by each other, No double or triple tubes, No running, Fighting is forbidden, Scuba equipment, No glass Containers. No dunking or chicken fighting. No children on adult or child shoulders.
- Please do not leave your valuables unattended. We are not responsible for lost or stolen Items.
- Baby Floats must be U.S. Coast Guard approved.
- Arm Floats that are U.S. Coast Guard approved and soft water toys (NO Noodles) are allowed in North West, San Jacinto, Fairmont Pools
- Showers are required before entering the pool after sunbathing with oils or, lotions.
- Please use the restrooms when needed or, before getting into pool.
- Swimsuits are required in all pools. A tank top may be worn over swimsuit. **NO STREET CLOTHES IN POOL (cut offs, jeans, cotton, basket ball or athletic shorts, sports bra`s or underwear for a swimsuit).**
- Persons whom have evidence of infection or, communicable disease are prohibited from the pool.
- Stairs and ladders are used for entering and exiting the pool.
- Please dispose of all trash Items in the trashcan.
- NO swimming unless a Lifeguard is on stand. The Lifeguard Is The pool authority and will enforce all rules. Problems at the pool should first be directed to the pool manager and then the Aquatic Coordinator @ 281-470-7275.
- SWIM DIAPERS ARE REQUIRED IF CHILD IF NOT POTTY TRAINED.
- NO ONE may go down the slide unless they are sitting on their bottom.
- Any Infraction of the above rules may result in loss of swimming privileges at any or all pools.
- CHILDREN 10 YEARS AND UNDER MUST ACCOPANYIED BY AT LEAST A 16 YEAR OLD.
