LPPD search warrant results in Cocaine seizure

In response to citizen complaints related to illegal narcotic activity in the 2000 block of Lomax Drive, a residential neighborhood in La Porte, Texas, the La Porte Police Department's Street Crimes Unit conducted a comprehensive investigation and were ultimately able to confirm that illegal narcotic activity was taking place at the address. A search warrant was quickly requested, obtained, and executed on March 7th with the assistance of the Department's Tactical Team.

As a result of the search warrant execution, Detectives confiscated more than 33 grams of cocaine, as well as marijuana and other drug related paraphernalia. As a result of this investigation, Drake Reichelderfer was arrested and subsequently charged with Possession of a Controlled Substance (PCS) with the intent to deliver.

Reichelderfer was transferred to the Harris County Jail where he remains with a bond \$30,000.
