LPISD student arrested for terroristic threats

On Tuesday morning, May 22nd, 2018 the La Porte Independent School District received a report that a Lomax Junior High School student allegedly made a terroristic threat while riding the bus. The La Porte Police Department was immediately contacted, and immediately conducted a thorough investigation leading to the arrest of the 14 year old male Lomax Junior High student.

School officials and the La Porte Police Department were made aware of this threat at approximately 8:30am this morning. After conducting the investigation, the School Resource Officer contacted the Harris County District Attorney's Office who accepted the charge of Terroristic Threat on the juvenile. The juvenile was arrested and transported to Harris County Juvenile Probation Center.

We again take this opportunity to remind parents to sit-down and talk with their children relating to the importance of school safety and make sure that each student understands that threatening violence on campus is not a “joking” matter. The safety of our children and the security of our school campuses is absolutely our number one priority. All threats will be investigated and all those making a threat will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
