Early this evening the La Porte Police Department (LPPD) was contacted by La Porte Independent School District (LPISD) Officials about a report that a Lomax Junior High School student allegedly made a terroristic threat regarding Lomax Junior High School.

LPPD made contact with the parents and student, reported to have made the threat. This incident is currently under a thorough investigation to ensure the safety of our students.

We again take this opportunity to remind parents to sit-down and talk with their children relating to the importance of school safety and make sure that each student understands that threatening violence on campus is not a “joking” matter. The safety of our children and the security of our school campuses is absolutely our number one priority. All threats will be investigated and all those making a threat will be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law.
