As a result of the agency's most recent backing, on October 14<sup>th</sup>, LPPD witnessed one of its supervisors complete Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command. Graduating from the program's 440<sup>th</sup> class, was La Porte Police Lieutenant John Krueger.

Northwestern University's School of Police Staff and Command is an intensive six-month program that prepares law enforcement managers for senior positions by uniquely combining academic principles with practical applications. Courses are taught at the University's main campus near Chicago, as well as multiple regional sites throughout the United States.

A renowned school among law enforcement officials nationwide, students engage in an intense course of study, whereupon graduates have studied, examined, and demonstrated skill in such areas as: Project Management; Statistics; Planning and Policies; Resource Allocation; Human Resources; Grant Writing; Traffic Engineering; Evaluating Products and Services; and the latest trends in Organizational Behavior.
